MINUTES OF THE April 14, 2009 MEETING

The Hebron Plan Commission meeting of April 14, 2009 was called to order by President Scott Sweeney. Also, in attendance were Pete Breuckman, Don Ensign, David Peeler, Steve Sibbrell, Bill Shillenn, Attorney Brian E. Less and Executive Secretary Joanne Garrett-Hansen. Following the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, the following business was conducted.

Approval of Minutes - On motion of David Peeler, seconded by Don Ensign and duly carried 6-0, the minutes of the March 10, 2009 were approved as submitted.

New Business:

Resignation of Don Ensign - Mr. Ensign noted that he will be officially resigning from the Commission at the end of this meeting. He noted that David Peeler was recently appointed to the Town Council and that Mr. Peeler will remain as the Council representative to the Commission.

113/118 Cherry Court - Discussion ensued regarding drainage between these properties. Attorney Less noted that this matter is a neighbor issue and not an issue of the Commission. The Commission that asked George Harness review the situation.

Old Business:

Colvin Property - Attorney Less reported that this is no longer under the jurisdiction of the Plan Commission as a suit has filed in the Porter Superior Court. He noted everything is now a public record and anyone can obtain copies of all documents via the court.

Master Plan - Don Ensign stated that the Town needs a 20/25 year master plan and that he anticipates a proposal for the preparation of one by next meeting.

There being no further business before the Commission, on motion of Pete Breuckman, seconded by Steve Sibbrell and duly carried 6-0, the meeting was adjourned.
