Resignation – Shawn presented a letter of resignation he received from Jeanne Steinhilber, on a motion made by Michael Mantai, seconded by Dick Bell, and duly carried 3-0, the letter of resignation was accepted.

Old Business

Website – The park board has agreed on a new design, it will take at least 2 weeks to be complete.

Business License – Mike and Shawn will be preparing the renewal forms, and mailing them out.

Seed Grant – Shawn is still working to find youth representation to accept the Seed Grant provided by the Porter County Community Foundation.

Desco – Jim introduce Chuck Eckenstohler. Jim will be assisting the Town create a 25 year master plan, providing funding is approved.

Industrial Park – *Discussion.* The location off of 231 was discussed as being a prime shovel ready site in Porter County. A committee needs to be established to address logical areas for an Industrial Park.
