

**HEBRON REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION
MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 2, 2009**

Mike Reick called to order the Hebron Redevelopment Commission on September 2, 2009 at 6:09 pm. In attendance were Mike Reick, Dick Bell, and Michael Mantai. After the Pledge of Allegiance the following business was conducted.

Claims – A motion was made by Dick Bell, seconded by Michael Mantai, and passed 3-0 to accept all claims as presented. (See Attach)

Minutes – On a motion by Dick Bell, seconded by Michael mantai and duly carried 3-0 the minutes of August 3, 2009 were approved as presented.

Web – New maps will are currently being added.

Newsletter – Chris was present to explain why a previous business article had been run again. He explained it was a last minute decission, and other options had already been denied. Chris will now be focusing on businesses in the Industrial Park. (Discussion) September's newsletter will be out September 28th, unless unforeseen obstacles prevent it.

Business License – 10 new renewals were received since theAugust meeting.

Chamber – Mike has been keeping an open line of communication with Donna at the Chamber, Chamber has been invited to make a donation towards the businness names on the new town banners.

Dairy Queen – The first ad has been run.

Banners – Mike brought samples and quotes for the Commission to discuss and vote on. These banners will be for 3 seasons of the year, and HRC will make the initial purchase, and the town will be responsible for future maintenance and handling.HRC will be purchasin 72 banners overall, 47 of these will have business names and web address on them, the others will have web only. The total cost of banners and hardware is \$15,573.00. A motion to move forward on the banner purchase contingent on the town not being held liable for any other banner contract and ordered by Monday September 7th was made by Michael Mantai, seconded by Dick Bell, and duly carried 3-0. These banners should be up in time for the October 3rd Re-opening celebration. (choices for the banners attached)
